Carpenters Wellness Center Changes

Please DO NOT come to the Wellness Center if any

of the following apply to you. Instead, please call your local health department for direction and testing if:

- You have been to any country categorized as a Level 2 or 3 Travel Health Notice by the CDC
- You have been in direct contact with someone who has recently returned from a country categorized as a Level 2 or 3 Travel Health Notice by the CDC



- You have been in direct contact with someone who is positive or suspected to positive for the COVID-19 virus
- You have any of the above risk factors and are symptomatic of COVID-19 (fever, cough, shortness
 of breath)

In an attempt to keep our patients and associates safe, we are not accepting walk-ins in the Wellness Center. You MUST have a scheduled and screened appointment prior to entering the facility. The Wellness Center will all be transitioning many appointments to virtual visits to further reduce congestion in the facility.

Jefferson Arms Update

The city's top three elected officials on Wednesday opposed a developer's request for a three-year extension of the deadline for rehabbing the long-vacant Jefferson Arms building downtown.

The unanimous vote by the Board of Estimate and Apportionment signaled members' displeasure with the years of delays in the \$104 million project. We've watched this project for years, and we'll continue to follow and make sure any work performed pays a living wage, benefits, and employs local workers.
