#### Building Boom

The biggest [capital improvement plan](#) to come to Illinois in years will bring more than 500,000 jobs and a jolt to the state's infrastructure construction. "This is more than an infrastructure plan," Gov. J.B. Pritzker said this past week. "This is a job creation plan the likes of which the state has never seen." The plan includes \$14 billion for new roads and bridges, most of it going to southern Illinois.



#### Like Father, Like Son

The name [Eugene Scalia](#) has emerged as the next NLRB chief. He's the son of late Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, who was [no friend to labor unions](#). The younger Scalia, who must be confirmed by the Senate, has also drawn criticism for putting big business ahead of workers.

*"Workers and union members who believed candidate Trump when he campaigned as pro-worker should feel betrayed,"* said Senate Minority Leader Chuck Schumer.

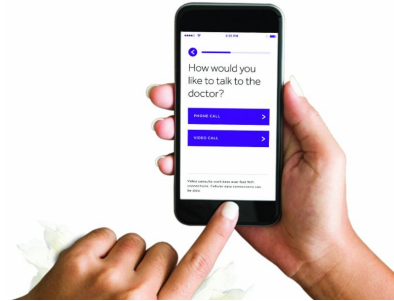
