


What a Year

Switcheroo

In conservative Kansas, there's some jumping ship going on as former GOPers see a brighter future on the other side of the aisle. "The party switching comes after a nationwide surge of Democratic voters in suburban areas, and some state lawmakers are now aligning themselves with this new political reality."





Incoming Kansas governor Laura Kelly wants Labor to have a louder voice in the Sunflower State. She has assembled a labor and commerce transition team (*Carpenters representative Joe Hudson – back row, second from left*) that is helping Kelly and her staff set policy and priorities for the next four years. One key recommendation: A stronger focus on fraudulent business practices, namely the **misclassification of workers** and the use of independent contractors. This has long been a topic of national concern within the United Brotherhood of Carpenters.


Onsite Smoking Cessation
