

Wish List

The U.S. House has passed the Protecting the Right to Organize Act, also known as the "PRO Act". The legislation, passed mostly along party lines, would provide sweeping changes that would help unions to organize employees and permit the NLRB to impose penalties on companies who retaliate. PRO Act is seen as a "wish list" for everything unions would like, but has also been called unrealistic with little chance for final passage in Congress.



Representation

The Missouri Democratic Party is joining the growing list of American workers wanting union representation. Staffers at the MDP officially submitted a demand for union recognition last week, something party leaders support. "We believe that unionizing as staff of MDP helps strengthen our party and build a brighter future for Missouri Democrats."
