

## CTE










Juniors and seniors from Freeburg Community High School spent Tuesday morning at our Belleville training school learning all about good-paying careers in union carpentry.

"Workers often endure threats, surveillance and even physical intimidation from their employers in the protracted process necessary to hold an election for union representation."

The Trump National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) issued a direct final rule last month that will make it harder for workers who want a union in their workplace to demand a fair election.
