Through the Roof

U.S. home construction is healthier than it's been since the Great Recession, surprising even the analysts. It's a sign that homebuyers are feeling optimistic about the economy. In figures released by the Commerce Department, housing starts jumped

more than 12% in August, and building permits – an indicator of future construction – are at a 12-year high.
